

3. War Sign

"And ye shall hear of wars... for nation shall rise against nation..."

(Matt. 24:6-7)

Hundreds of wars have been fought in the 20th century. Fear of nuclear destruction dominates today, and some think a third world war is imminent The world spends \$800

6. Knowledge Sign

"...and knowledge shall be increased." (Daniel 12:4)

Today we see an explosion in knowledge. Man has made more advancements in science, medicine, transport, communication, and every other area of knowledge in the past century, than in all previous centuries put together.

1. Seas Roaring Sign

(Luke 21:25)

The Asian tsunami of Dec 26th, 2004 killed over 300,000, with millions left injured and homeless. The sea and waves were certainly roaring that day.



There is no shortage of famine today. As each day passes, thousands die, and many others suffer for want of basic daily necessities. Today there are more than 800 million malnourished people in the world. As each day passes, 35,000 children die from hunger, malnutrition, and disease.



7. Noah's Day Sign

"But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man [Jesus] be." (Matt. 24:37)

Noah's day was marred by violence (Genesis 6:11) and immorality. Just as in Noah's day, today's people ignore the consequences of their evil living. They no longer thank God for life, because pleasure is put first. "In the last days... men shall be lovers of.. pleasures more than lovers of God." 2 Timothy 3:1-4.




5. Pestilence Sign

The Spanish infl uenza epidemic of 1918 killed an estimated 21 million people. Today the AIDS virus is affecting 6,000 young people every day. The Ebola virus, Mad Cow disease, and others, are becoming immune to the strongest antibiotics.



Crime is increasing dramatically. In Australia in 1997, there were 130,406 motor vehicles stolen. 328,869 unlawful entries with intent, 123,940 assaults, 14,138 sexual assaults, 322 murders, and 557 kidnappings - and it is on the rise!

Earthquakes have increased. In the 1980s there were 9,842 recorded. The year 2001 saw 21,988 earthquakes. As each year passes, the number of quakes recorded is increasing in intensity and severity.
